#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Thank you, umpires, for the opportunity to serve as your President for these past three seasons.

As I gathered my thoughts for this year's President's Report, I reviewed my comments last year, and these have proved prophetic:

Cricket is a game of numbers – runs, wickets, all types of stats – and for us, umpiring is, too. Some numbers that really matter are our total membership...and our average age. The meaning of these numbers is our real challenge as an association – we are getting older, and we need to keep regenerating, to attract new members, and younger members.

One thing we could each do...is to use every contact with current players to let them know how much fun there is in umpiring, and...attract one or two into our ranks for this or next season.

...I thank outgoing VSDCA President Jack Sheehan and his Executive and all VSDCA clubs for sustaining our unique cricketing arrangement. We are all aware of the challenges...in the re-structure of Victorian cricket; the VSDCA is "going it alone"...outside the embrace of Cricket Victoria.

...as a collective (we need) to keep up with our knowledge and skills...attendance at general meetings is essential. Taking part in our meetings is an obligation membership of our association, so come on umps – let's see you there this season.

...club umpires...have by and large remained outside our association, but I hope that we can see more of them in our meetings and company in the coming years.

I repeat that summary here because we still face those same challenges.

The simple fact is, to run a proper competition at the standard we enjoy, a full panel of umpires is needed.

Our post-season review was informed by the Member Survey that many umpires completed online in March, and reported separately earlier. What impresses most about the responses is how even they were, and the strong conviction that the cricket and player standards in our competition is very good. To me, that says "This is worth working hard for!"

If it's worth working for, we need to work smarter. The VSDCA Executive has started the ball rolling by appointing John Doig and Brian Goodman to the roles of Umpiring Director and Umpires' Coach respectively. I hope this will lead to more education and discussion about the Laws and Competition Rules and that we all better prepared for the little surprises that each Saturday brings us.

As I leave the role as President, I urge all umpires and officials to work together in a spirit of open cooperation to ensure our competition remains where we want it to be – as a model of good contest and sportsmanship. If there is a concern, make it known to your Committee and have it aired and resolved; better this than to allow that concern to become a larger problem...umpires and VSDCA officials please note in equal measure.

In closing I pay special thanks to some special people – to Jim Earle, whose courteous and calm manner make him the perfect Umpiring Manager; to Dr Geoff Hart, whose regular updates from the VSDCA Executive keep us so well informed; to the VSDCUA Executive Committee members, whose support and hard work on behalf of umps make everything tick over so smoothly; and finally to you, the members of our association, whose comradeship makes umpiring all the more enjoyable.

#### Report on the Financial Report

The procedures selected depend upon the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the committee, as well as evaluation of the overall presentation of the financial report.

#### J G CRAIG

J G CRAIG UNDER 15 COMPETITION (Formerly the R M Hatch Competition)

The VSDCA established the R M Hatch under 15 competition in 1969 as a vehicle for their promotion of cricket. The competition was named in honour of Ron Hatch, whose involvement with sub-district cricket spanned almost 60 years as Delegate, Secretary, and President for 27 years, and as Patron until his passing in 1987.

Season 2014-15 saw the name changed to honour the work and dedication of VSDCA stalwart John Craig.

Since 1972, the VSDCUA has presented a trophy to the best player in each section and since 1978 these presentations have been made at the Grand Final of the competition.

The player judged to have performed best in the Grand Final, as selected by the Grand Final Umpires, has been presented with the Ian Aitken Trophy in honour of the umpiring legend. Since season 2011-12, after Ian's untimely death, the award has been presented by Ian's wife Dorothy.
