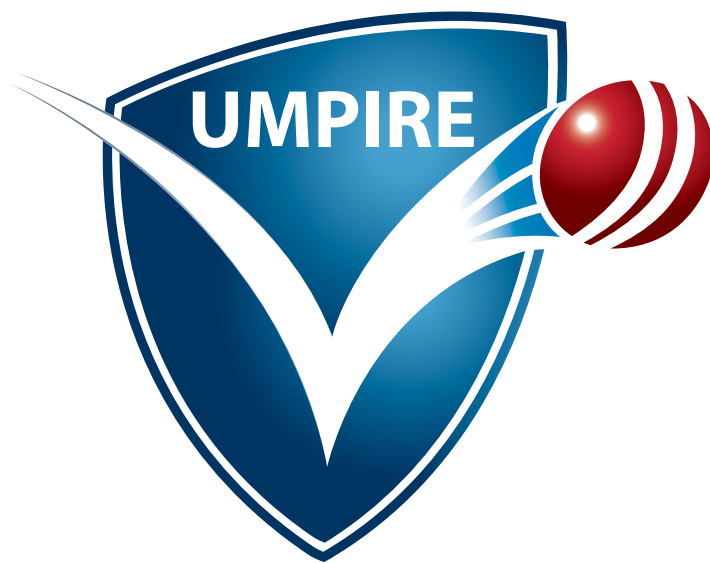

Together with the Director of Umpiring, we tried a central venue for meetings at Cricket Victoria with a view to moving with them to the new facility at the Junction Oval. There were some challenges and it was decided to move back to suburbia and with Caulfield RSL not being available the Glasshouse at Caulfield Racecourse was utilised.

I do hope we can get back to using Cricket Victoria as a central venue for all given that we have Umpires residing and spread from inner to outer suburban, urban and country.

I was pleased to announce that East Malvern Community Branch of Bendigo Bank provided sponsorship of \$5000 which is to go toward our replacement uniforms in the coming season.

Gallagher Bassett also continued their sponsorship with a further \$3000.

## J G CRAIG

### J G CRAIG UNDER 15 COMPETITION (Formerly the R M Hatch Competition)

The VSDCA established the R M Hatch under 15 competition in 1969 as a vehicle for their promotion of cricket. The competition was named in honour of Ron Hatch, whose involvement with sub-district cricket spanned almost 60 years as Delegate, Secretary, and President for 27 years, and as Patron until his passing in 1987.

Season 2014-15 saw the name changed to honour the work and dedication of VSDCA stalwart John Craig.

Since 1972, the VSDCUA has presented a trophy to the best player in each section and since 1978 these presentations have been made at the Grand Final of the competition.

The player judged to have performed best in the Grand Final, as selected by the Grand Final Umpires, has been presented with the Ian Aitken Trophy in honour of the umpiring legend. Since season 2011-12, after Ian's untimely death, the award has been presented by Ian's wife Dorothy.
