PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Another year, another season, another occasion to reflect on how fortunate we are to be involved in the game we love...no longer making the minimum, never having 0/100 against our name..AND we have the best seat in the house. What a joy to be an umpire!

Thanks to all umps for their continued devotion to the game, to our unique competition, to their colleagues, and to our association.

Cricket is a game of numbers – runs, wickets, all types of stats – and for us, umpiring is, too. Some numbers that really matter are our total membership (slightly up, but really, stable in 2015-2016), and our average age (at least one year older in 2015-2016). The season also reinforced the need for us as a collective to keep up with our knowledge and skills and how valuable that is. Report on the Financial Report

In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the committee, as well as evaluation of the overall presentation of the financial report.

J G CRAIG UNDER 15 COMPETITION (Formerly the R M Hatch Competition)

The VSDCA established the R M Hatch under 15 competition in 1969 as a vehicle for their promotion of cricket. The competition was named in honour of Ron Hatch, whose involvement with sub-district cricket spanned almost 60 years as Delegate, Secretary, and President for 27 years, and as Patron until his passing in 1987.

Season 2014-15 saw the name changed to honour the work and dedication of VSDCA stalwart John Craig.

Since 1972, the VSDCUA has presented a trophy to the best player in each section and since 1978 these presentations have been made at the Grand Final of the competition.

The player judged to have performed best in the Grand Final, as selected by the Grand Final Umpires, has been presented with the Ian Aitken Trophy in honour of the umpiring legend. Since season 2011-12, after Ian's untimely death, the award has been presented by Ian's wife Dorothy.
