#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Our numbers continue to grow, and for that we owe thanks to many – to the VSDCA Umpires' Advisor Paul Jensen (good people attract good people), to the VSCDCA recruitment specialist, our very own Brian Goodman (a little more of Brian below), to the VSDCA itself for running an excellent competition that attracts good people, to the VSDCA again for retaining such an outstanding umpiring manager as James Earle, and lastly to the umpires of the VSDCUA for their openness toward new colleagues and their preparedness to share, to educate and to learn from each other.

There were many milestones during the year, each of which was carefully recorded by Jim Earle. One or two significant events are worthy of an additional mention,

- the resignation of Mike Doughty as he moves into a new phase of life, "down on the Peninsula"
- Brian Goodman's 350th 1st XI game.

The season past brought with it an increase in fees for all Saturday and J G Craig fixtures. Thank you to the VSDCA for this consideration and to VSDCUA Past President Peter White for pursuing this matter on behalf of umpires.

A sad event produced a memorable afternoon of unity and solidarity during the season, when on Saturday 29th November, players, umpires, and officials joined in silent tribute before play to mark the death of Phillip Hughes. At many grounds, bats were put out on display, too. The freakish accident that killed Phil was a reminder to us all of the fragile nature of our existence and the ever-present physical danger in our game. As our cricket community came together, though, it also reminded of the comradeship that the game engenders.

Some trends were developing throughout the season, and one we disregard at our peril – on a number of occasions umpires were unwell during a game, and some umpires missed periods of the season through illness. The fact is, none of us is getting younger, and we need to take care of our physical well-being. It is much better to be unavailable than to be a casualty of the game, and I implore all umpires to get themselves checked (eyes, ears, general health) and ready for play as we commence 2015-2016.

Another undesirable trend is the fall off in attendance at General Meetings, and at VSDCUA functions. Participation in General Meetings is an obligation of membership, and unless compelling circumstances dictate otherwise, Umpires are therefore obliged to take part. Where Umps can't be there, of course, everyone understands; however I ask the incoming Committee to look closely at the practice of recording apologies and acknowledge only those submitted prior to the commencement of the Meeting.

On the other hand, our two annual functions, the 200 Club Lunch and the pre-Finals Dinner, are celebrations of umpiring, and of particular Umpires *in particular*. I'm asking all Umps to re-assess their ability to come to these events to join with their fellows to celebrate outstanding service at one (the 200 Club) and outstanding form at the other (pre-Finals Dinner).

Now, grumbles aside, again, I thank all umpires for their comradeship and support, and thank especially members of the VSDCUA Committee, whose generous sharing of knowledge has been invaluable to me, a newbie President.

As this Addendum is written, it is a very cold and wet Melbourne winter's day – and that means that spring is not far away. The days are getting longer, and soon we'll be able to see the grass growing... can hardly wait, can you?

#### **Report on the Financial Report**

I have audited the accompanying financial report, being a special purpose financial report of Victorian Sub District Cricket Umpires Association Inc (a Non-reporting Association) (the association), which comprises the balance sheet as at 30 April 2015 and the income statement for the year then ended, a summary of significant accounting policies, other explanatory notes and the statement by members of the committee.

#### Committee's Responsibility for the Financial Report

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial report. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the committee, as well as evaluation the overall presentation of the financial report.

The financial report has been prepared for distribution to members for the purpose of fulfilling the committee's financial reporting under the Associations Incorporation Act. I disclaim any assumption of responsibility for any reliance on this report or on the financial report to which it relates to any person other than the members, or for any purpose other than that for which it was prepared.

I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my audit opinion.

#### Independence

In conducting our audit, I have complied with the independence requirements of Australian professional ethical pronouncements.

#### J G CRAIG

J G CRAIG UNDER 15 COMPETITION (Formerly the R M Hatch Competition)

The VSDCA established the R M Hatch under 15 competition in 1969 as a vehicle for their promotion of cricket. The competition was named in honour of Ron Hatch, whose involvement with sub-district cricket spanned almost 60 years as Delegate, Secretary, and President for 27 years, and as Patron until his passing in 1987.

Season 2014-15 saw the name changed to honour the work and dedication of VSDCA stalwart John Craig.

Since 1972, the VSDCUA has presented a trophy to the best player in each section and since 1978 these presentations have been made at the Grand Final of the competition.

The player judged to have performed best in the Grand Final, as selected by the Grand Final Umpires, has been presented with the Ian Aitken Trophy in honour of the umpiring legend. Since season 2011-12, after Ian's untimely death, the award has been presented by Ian's wife Dorothy.
