We welcomed Michael Moore, Michael Moss and Warren Pump to the Committee and I thank all members of the Committee for their contributions during the year.

Meeting regularly as a Committee we discussed and resolved many issues including liaising with the VSDCA Executive on some matters.

Our regular members meetings were held at the central venue of Cricket Victoria CitiPower Centre which gave us all the facilities we need including the opportunity for after meeting fellowship. Our membership is widespread around the metro and urban areas and thus a central venue with good transport access is beneficial.

I understand that Cricket Victoria will be moving forward with Stage 2 development soon and they, the Government and Parks Victoria have been in discussion regarding parking in the area.

J G CRAIG UNDER 15 COMPETITION (Formerly the R M Hatch Competition)

The VSDCA established the R M Hatch under 15 competition in 1969 as a vehicle for their promotion of cricket. The competition was named in honour of Ron Hatch, whose involvement with sub-district cricket spanned almost 60 years as Delegate, Secretary, and President for 27 years, and as Patron until his passing in 1987.

Season 2014-15 saw the name changed to honour the work and dedication of VSDCA stalwart John Craig.

Since 1972, the VSDCUA has presented a trophy to the best player in each section and since 1978 these presentations have been made at the Grand Final of the competition.

The player judged to have performed best in the Grand Final, as selected by the Grand Final Umpires, has been presented with the Ian Aitken Trophy in honour of the umpiring legend. Since season 2011-12, after Ian's untimely death, the award has been presented by Ian's wife Dorothy.
