COVID-19 came at the end of our cricket season and saw the Grand final matches not played in VSDCA.

Whilst it was disappointing for the appointed Umpires and players the health of everyone was paramount as outlined by VSDCA.

As we look to the future uncertainty still remains as to what Cricket in season 2020/21 will look like and for us as Umpires how we may need to adjust to the new Cricketing world.

The VSDCUA had a good year.

Our membership was up, our meetings were well attended and financially we are in a sound position.

We continued to operate in accordance with our rules under the Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012 with myself as President, Michael Moore VP, Michael Moss as Secretary, Warren Pump as Treasurer with Colin Newport, John Robinson and Adam Devlin forming the Committee.

Merv Hindson stepped aside at the AGM and a presentation was made to him at the Pre-Finals Dinner Meeting in thanks for his contribution to the Committee and Association.

Other presentations included Brian Goodman receiving a special presentation in recognition of umpiring 500 games in VSDCA.

Bill Finnigan was presented with a Certificate acknowledging his umpiring of 200 1st XI games in VSDCA by VSDCA Chairman Phil O'Meara.

Brian Farrow received his VSDCUA 100 games medallion and bar.

The Matt Harris Award for the Most Improved Umpire was presented to Matthew Pearce.

The Committee met on six occasions during the season.

The general membership also met 6 times with attendances averaging 50 members with some 70 in attendance at our preseason meeting.

Meetings are held at CitiPower Centre, the home of Cricket Victoria, commonly known as the Junction Oval, St Kilda.

At these meetings Umpires Coach Brian Goodman provides excellent information/training for Umpires.

These presentations are recorded and Michael Moore attends to the placing of this information on our various media sites which are being well received.

This then becomes available to the wider cricket community.

The VSDCA is represented at our meetings which enables two-way feedback and any issues can be quickly resolved.

John Doig (Director of Umpiring) and Neill Murray (Umpires Appointment Manager) also form part of our General meetings and we thank them for their input.

Neill has the unenviable task of doing the appointments, together with the VSDCA Umpires Committee, and this year has been made much more difficult by the weather conditions and Umpires availability or late withdrawals.

What was pleasing this year was to hear that the standard of umpiring had improved, as per Captains Reports, so everyone is to be congratulated.

This year new items of apparel were available with another new match day shirt provided free due to the sponsorship of East Malvern Community Bank. Caps which can be worn when umpiring T20's were made available at no cost. New hats at a subsidized cost added to a professional look of our Umpires in uniform.

Our new batch of Umpiring Jackets, again available at a subsidized cost, had an inside pocket inserted.

We have received very positive feedback from the VSDCA Executive regarding our uniform and the way we present on match days.

Any changes to Uniform require the approval of VSDCA.

Thankyou to the Umpires who came to collect apparel and to those members who were the conduit in getting apparel around the suburbs.

Financially we are in a sound position, thanks to the \$5000 sponsorship from East Malvern Community Bank, \$500 from Icon Sportswear and we receive \$2800 from VSDCA on behalf of Club Umpires which helps defray the cost of uniforms to them.

With the cooperation of the Bank we were able to provide EFTPOS facilities at our meetings as another avenue to pay memberships/clothing costs etc.

Manager of East Malvern Community Bank, Ruth Hall, attended two of our meetings.

Given the current economic conditions sponsorship will be much more difficult to obtain in the future so we as an Association will have to budget accordingly.

We do have a rolling 3-year Budget in place.

As a guest of VSDCA I represented the VSDCUA at the T20's finals and luncheon, and also attended the J G Craig finals to present the Trophies, donated by VSDCUA, to Best Players in each Zone.

This past season saw many new Umpires join our ranks, with some through the VSDCA Academy and also from Premier Cricket.

Welcome and I hope you enjoyed your season and we look forward to many more.



Congratulations to the many Umpires who reached milestones during the year and to those appointed to finals.

As always, we need to recruit more Umpires and this will become more important should the VSDCA expand the number of Clubs in the competition.

Contact is maintained with Phil O'Meara and Ken Hilton of VSDCA and Dr Geoff Hart attends our meetings so the lines of communication are open.

To Peter White the Umpires Advocate thankyou for your support of Umpires as required during the season.

To my Committee of Michael Moss, the ever reliable Secretary keeping the records and keeping up communication to members, Michael Moore on the Social media, Warren Pump maintaining the finances under control, Colin Newport getting information out through the App, John Robinson and Adam Devlin contributing on their allotted duties a sincere thankyou for your deliberations and efforts on behalf of the membership of VSDCUA.

Michael Moore has indicated he will not be continuing on the Committee so a sincere thankyou for the efforts you have put in on introducing the various social media platforms, updating the website, recording meeting presentations and in general modernisation of this area of the Association. We had guest speakers in former Premier Cricket Umpires, Vince Borg & Frank Fabris who joined the VSDCA umpiring group, outlining how umpires can enhance their performances on match days, which showed a number of different ways to go about how we umpire and what makes a good umpire.

I would like to thank ALL umpires for their willingness to be coached and take on board areas of improvement for the betterment of the competition.

Another real benefit is the interactions and discussions about so many different things that happen during matches that enable each and every umpire to learn from, as well as the friendships that can be made and enhanced.

I would like to thank all the Club Umpires for their continued commitment to our competition by assisting the VSDCA, which has enabled most matches to have two umpires officiating.

Ian Wyatt, who is one of our most experienced umpires, deserves congratulations on his appointment to the 3-day U21 match where Ian's umpiring performance received overwhelming praise from both teams, well done Ian.

## **Report on the Financial Report**

The review also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the committee, as well as evaluation the overall presentation of the financial report.

I disclaim any assumption of responsibility for any reliance on this report or on the financial report to which it relates to any person other than the members, or for any purpose other than that for which it was prepared.



### J G CRAIG UNDER 15 COMPETITION (Formerly the R M Hatch Competition)

The VSDCA established the R M Hatch under 15 competition in 1969 as a vehicle for their promotion of cricket. The competition was named in honour of Ron Hatch, whose involvement with sub-district cricket spanned almost 60 years as Delegate, Secretary, and President for 27 years, and as Patron until his passing in 1987.

Season 2014-15 saw the name changed to honour the work and dedication of VSDCA stalwart John Craig.

Since 1972, the VSDCUA has presented a trophy to the best player in each section and since 1978 these presentations have been made at the Grand Final of the competition.

The player judged to have performed best in the Grand Final, as selected by the Grand Final Umpires, has been presented with the Ian Aitken Trophy in honour of the umpiring legend. Since season 2011-12, after Ian's untimely death, the award has been presented by Ian's wife Dorothy.
