VSDCUA – PRESIDENTS REPORT 2023 – 2024:

It once again gives me much pleasure to present my second President's report on behalf of the VSDCUA.

At the time of writing last season's report, we found ourselves exiting out of Covid-19 Pandemic restrictions, but VSDCA still have some guidelines in place as the virus is still prevalent, and as such we still needed to be wary. There was some impact on numbers available to be appointed, but thankfully through good practice by our membership we managed to keep any disruption to a minimum.

It is with much regret that we learned in August 2023, of the passing of a former colleague in Geoff Tait. Geoff joined us from Premier Cricket in 1998 and umpired 223 games, amongst which were 178 in 1st XI, and 26 finals, which included two 1st XI Grand Finals and a 2nd XI Championship Final. He also umpired the 2002 Under 14 Hatch Cup Final. He was made a life member in 2008 and a member of our '200 Club' in 2014. He enjoyed a reputation of being supportive, and a methodical planner and as such, a great partner for new umpires.

We experienced a mild summer, but Melbourne's weather reputation soon gave us a reminder of what we had missed, with a heatwave testing us out during the first round of finals. However the dedication of our panel overcame these conditions, and we were able to efficiently deliver our services, which was much appreciated by the clubs and players.

Once again congratulations are due to the VSDCA Umpiring Department. Appointments Officer Neill Murray carried out his role and its associated challenges in his normal efficient manner. The other members in Brian Goodman (Umpires Coach) and John Doig (Umpire Recruitment Manager) delivered presentations at our monthly meetings and their enthusiasm for their roles has not waned. They both continue to find new ways to make their presentations relevant and interesting.

We were fortunate to secure the use of the excellent facilities at the Brunswick Cricket Club for our meetings and to Rod Browning and his committee, we are sincerely indebted. We were also able to offer meals pre-meeting through the culinary skills of our fellow panel member Michael Moore. His post meeting offerings were also very popular with those in attendance. Thanks Mick and to your colleagues at Brunswick.



Once again, our End of year Dinner was held at Sandy by the Bay, the fourth such edition of this event. The facilities and dinner were both excellent. Thanks to James Barrett for his organisation of the evening and to Ash Hewawasam of Hampers Galore who provided a raffle prize.

A feature of this season's event was the presentation of an honorary life membership, bestowed on our late President Adam Devlin. We were privileged to have Adam's family present to witness his wife Marie accept the award.

Congratulations go out to Graham Hill, Brian Farrow, Ray Stokes, and Geoff Cowen on being awarded Life Membership at our AGM.

A number of other significant milestone awards were presented on the night, with Matthew Raby being recognised for umpiring his 400th 1st XI game and also for umpiring 500 VSDCA games.

Greg Rollo received his 300-game bar, Greg's 300th game was also his 100th 2nd XI game. 100 game bars were also presented to Paul Loughrey and Warren Pump.

Leigh Francis, John Doig and Michael Moore were presented with their '200 Club' membership certificates.

Peter Frencham and Gary White who were apologies, were also recognised during the season for umpiring their 400th and 300th games, respectively. These awards will be presented at our next AGM.

The Matt Harris Award for the Most Improved Umpire was presented to Justin Toohey, and like previous recipients, he was a worthy winner of this award. Justin was also appointed to umpire the VSDCA v Victoria Country representative game.

To all who achieved milestones during the season, our heartiest congratulations and we look forward to you all reaching many more in the future.

To our Club Umpires, some of whom found themselves appointed to 2nd XI and Craig Shield games, well done on your performances. Some were also called upon to help in finals and did so with distinction.

Keeping up a time-honoured tradition, I attended the J.G. Craig Grand final hosted by Ormond Cricket Club, to present the trophies to the best players in each Zone. Congratulations to Croydon Cricket Club on winning the tournament. It was also pleasing once again to have Ken Aitken at the game to present the Best Player Award, named after his late father Ian.

Our financial position remains strong and stable, due in no short way to the continuing outstanding efforts of our Treasurer Warren. The East Malvern branch of the Bendigo Community Bank granted us a further \$3,500 sponsorship and Icon Sportswear \$500.00.

To my Vice President and Apparel Manager James Barrett, congratulations on a great job. His efforts and diligence, especially in the apparel and sponsorship areas were exceptional. His organising of a number of accessories and sunscreen in a kit for use by umpires on match days was a major effort on his part. He is an invaluable asset to our organisation.

It is necessary again repeat what I touched on in last season's report, that we are becoming an older cohort, and it is a challenge every year to maintain umpire numbers. Our Recruiting Manager managed to sign up twenty-five new umpires, but circumstances did not allow us to have full use of their services for the whole of the

season. Society is changing and a long-term commitment to umpiring does not seem to be attractive as it once was. Having said that we do have a number of younger members on the panel who have such a commitment which is heartening to see.

In response to this need to recruit more umpires, the committee undertook the task of upgrading our website, a situation also brought about by the previous host closing their service. Fusion Graphics were used in the building of the website, and committee member Darren Clifford took on the role of webmaster. Again, I ask you all to sound out colleagues who might be interested in coming over to Subbies, taking up or indeed resuming umpiring, or if you know of a player who is retiring urge them to give umpiring a go! There is an incentive award for umpires who bring new members into our ranks.

Congratulations to all umpires who were appointed to finals and well done to those who received a Grand Final appointment.

To everyone I trust you had an enjoyable season, and on the feedback, it can be said with some confidence that we all helped in maintaining the umpiring standards that the VSDCA have enjoyed in the past and indeed expect.

Thanks again to my fellow committee members and all the panel members for your support and I urge you all to stay well and come back ready to tackle another exciting season in 2024-25.

In addition to that we had a further six who decide for various reasons to withdraw before the season started. However, they requested to be recontacted regarding the upcoming summer season, and we had a few who only wanted to umpire on Sunday's.

Fortunately, we were also buoyed by several of the club umpires joining the panel and a few former quality VSDCA umpires rejoining the team.

I want to give a shout out to Neill Murray and Benny Goodman for the effort and time they put into every single round with umpire appointments. I am sure it is difficult to get the mix right every for match, considering they review the captain's reports, support the training of new umpires, pairing them with the right partners, promoting umpires that are going well, and putting together their regular fireside chat, which is always of interest to everyone.

Those who joined the panel are all quality people, who have a zest for cricket and love umpiring in the VSDCA.

The increase in fees, and payments once per month directly into bank accounts was a brave and successful move. The income from multiple matches flowing into your account, was always pleasing when the payments went through. It also removed the anxiety of chasing up teams for the match payment. Finally, I want to congratulate Justin Toohey, who received the Matt Harris Award for the most improved umpire in the VSDCA. Well done mate, such a well-deserved recognition!

Report on the Financial Report



JG Craig Under 15 Competition (Formerly the RM Hatch Competition)

The VSDCA established the R M Hatch under 15 competition in 1969 as a vehicle for the promotion of cricket. The competition was named in honour of Ron Hatch, Whose involvement with Sub-District cricket spanned almost 60 years as Delegate, Secretary and President for 27 years as well as being Patron to the organisation until his passing in 1987.

Season 2014-15 saw the name changed to honour the work and dedication of VSDCA stalwart Mr. John Craig.

Since 1972, the VSDCUA has presented a trophy to the best player in each section and since 1978 these presentations have been made at the Grand final.

The Premiers in 2024 were Croydon 5/173 (43.3) beating Brighton 9/172 (45).

Show self-discipline even when things go against you.

Congratulate the opposition on their successes and enjoy those of your own team.

Thank the officials and your opposition at the end of the match, whatever the result.

Cricket is an exciting game that encourages leadership, friendship, and teamwork, which brings together people from different nationalities, cultures and religions, especially when played within the Spirit of Cricket.
